

Results from our invasive diagnostic procedures: last 3 years experience

Objective

To review the results of our invasive procedures database.

Methods

We have reviewed 330 invasive diagnostic procedures made between January 2011 and April 2014. We analyzed: indications of the technique, prior ultrasound results, patient history, number of punctions, reason of the revocations, results and complications.

Results

We performed 80 chorionic biopsies, 217 amniocentesis. 33 patients rejected the technique.

Conclusion

We observed an increase in the number of chorionic biopsies, although the number of amniocentesis remains majority. The complications found are consistent with those reported in the literature.

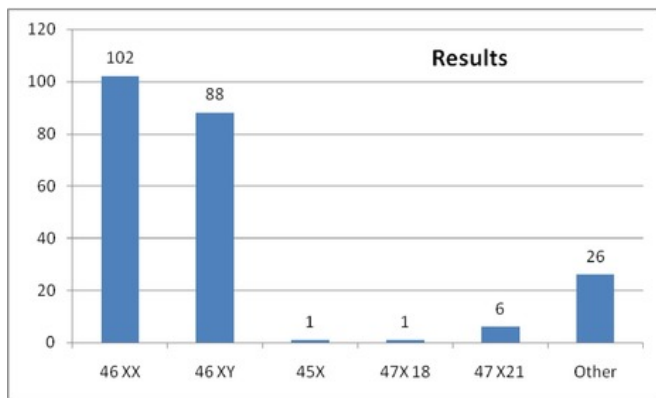


Figure 1. Frequency of referral for FE by indication and prenatal detection rate of CHD
